Objectives:

No.	Objective
1-	Ensure the physical and psychological safety of students and staff.
2-	Promote awareness and education about safety and well-being within the university community.
3-	Establish effective channels for reporting, addressing, and resolving safety concerns.
4-	Develop and maintain emergency response procedures to minimize risks during incidents.
5-	Provide accessible mental health and counseling services.
6-	Cultivate a campus culture that values inclusion, respect, and mutual support.

No.	Procedure
1-	Conduct regular safety training for students, faculty, and staff, including first aid and emergency response.
2-	Ensure campus facilities meet safety and accessibility standards.
3-	Implement a secure reporting system for safety concerns, harassment, or discrimination.
4-	Provide mental health support through counseling centers and partnerships with external organizations.
5-	Regularly update and practice emergency protocols for incidents like fire, earthquakes, or medical emergencies.
6-	Install and maintain surveillance systems and campus-wide security measures.
7-	Collaborate with local law enforcement and community organizations for enhanced safety resources.
8-	Organize workshops and awareness campaigns on topics like cyber safety, anti-bullying, and personal safety.
