
Policy (Arabic):

By adhering to this policy, BAU prioritizes public safety, occupational health, and environmental protection, while supporting the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being, SDG 12: Responsible Consumption and Production).

Scope:

This policy applies to all university staff, students, contractors, and visitors involved in all activities generating waste.

Objectives:

No.	Objective
1-	Guarantee that hazardous waste disposal practices comply with Jordanian environmental legislation and international standards
2-	Safeguard public safety, occupational health, and the well-being of students, staff, and the surrounding community
3-	Foster a culture of responsibility and awareness among staff, students, and contractors about safe and sustainable waste management practices
4-	Align waste disposal practices with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being, SDG 12: Responsible Consumption and Production)
5-	Minimize environmental risks by ensuring proper handling, storage, and disposal of hazardous waste.
6-	Mentor waste segregation and labeling systems across the BAU campus.

Related Procedures:

No.	Procedure
1-	Classification: Identify and label all hazardous waste types clearly.
2-	Collection & Storage: Collect waste in safe, designated containers and store in approved facilities.
3-	Transportation: Transport waste securely and only through licensed contractors.
4-	Disposal: Dispose of hazardous waste using legal and environmentally sound methods (incineration, recycling, or treatment).
5-	Training: Provide continuous training for staff and students on safe handling.
6-	Monitoring: Conduct regular inspections and maintain records to ensure compliance with laws and standards.
